This play is just as well performed as it is written. While the gentle introduction may fool you into thinking that nothing new will be offered up, your attention is soon seized and held captive as the nightmare of domestic violence unfolds. The fact that such a situation arises within a same-sex relationship adds a new slant to the genre, and so passionate are the performances by the three cast (*Alex Baker, Craig Henderson, Neil Harris*), that the audience is left feeling as frightened as the abused man. The power dynamic between all three characters is sensitively presented, with the action moving at a steady pace and building to a brutal climax which is handled with care and leaves the audience breathless.
